PRACTICAL INFORMATION

BERTHING

Especially for the AGM we arranged a reduction on the berthing fee, including the week before and after the AGM. Price will be €1,80 per meter/day, reservation in advance and payment to the organising committee.



ACCOMODATION

For the people without boats we made an arrangement with the <u>AmstelBotel</u>, a floating hotel at 5 minutes walking distance from the Marina, for € 95,- incl. tax, breakfast is optional.
